SKI TRIP HIGHLIGHTS:

Join 62 Christian singles for an incredible 6-day/5-night ski trip to world-famous Breckenridge Ski Resort in Colorado from January 14th to January 19th. The price of this trip is an amazing \$698 and includes roundtrip airfare on Frontier Airlines from Austin to Denver, roundtrip transfers between Denver and Breckenridge, 5 nights lodging in the ski-in/ski-out 5-star BlueSky Condominiums, and a 3-day "Colorado Lift-Ticket" that gives you access to not only Breckenridge, but to four other nearby ski resorts. We will depart Austin on Frontier Airlines at 2:40 p.m. on Friday, January 14th and arrive back on Wednesday evening, January 19th, at 10:52 p.m. The dates for this trip were strategically chosen to take advantage of the MLK holiday weekend to minimize time off work for those of you who get that holiday. Breckenridge is located less than two hours away from Denver International Airport in the beautiful Rocky Mountains. In order to offer this incredible ski trip at the low price of \$698, all bedding in the two-bedroom two-bath condos is maximized to accommodate 6 persons each. Each two-bedroom/two-bath condo has a king-bed in one bedroom, two twin beds or a "captain's bunk" in a second bedroom, and a queen-sized sleeper sofa in the living room. For those who have been to Whistler with me and stayed at the Aspens condos, the bedding configuration is almost identical. **The package price does not include** ski or snowboard rentals; meals; tips, or personal incidentals such as laundry, souvenirs; and insurance.



BRECKENRIDGE SKI RESORT

The 2,358 acre ski resort has a vertical rise of 3,398 feet and 30 lifts including two high-speed six SuperChairs and seven high-speed quads. The longest trail - Four O'Clock - is 3.5 miles long. All that terrain, professional grooming, and down-home atmosphere make it easy to see why this area is such a favorite. An 8-passenger gondola links the town to Breckenridge Ski Resort, calling it - the BreckConnect™. It runs visitors between the town and the ski resort's base area at Peak 8.

Terrain Classification

- **Easiest 14%:**
Breckenridge boasts some of the best learning terrain anywhere. Skiers and riders will find most beginner trails located off Chair 7 on Peak 8, including a portion the 3.5 mile Four O' Clock run, the longest trail at Breckenridge, and the Quicksilver Super6 and A lifts on Peak 9.
- **More Difficult 31%:**
An intermediate's paradise, Peak 7 is home to seven new gently rolling more difficult runs, accessed by a six-passenger SuperChair. Undoubtedly the local's favorite, Claimjumper is located on Peak 8 in addition to Northstar and Crescendo. Two high-speed SuperChairs on Peak 9 access more than ten intermediate trails for non-stop skiing and riding.
- **Most Difficult 19%:**
Duke's Run on Peak 8 offers a winning combination of both bumps and groomed terrain. Take the T-Bar up to Pika, Ptarmigan, White Crown and Forget-Me-Not for wide-open bowls and stunning views. Peak 9's Peerless is a great place to learn how to master the bumps, while bump masters will appreciate 6-Chair, especially on a powder day. A quick ride up the Falcon SuperChair on Peak 10 wisks skiers and riders to three advanced intermediate groomers, steep and deep bump runs, and the legendary glades of The Burn.
- **Expert 36%:**
Peak 7 offers vast steep terrain without the trees at a 45-degree pitch. On Peak 8, the experienced skier and rider can enjoy amazing alpine vistas from atop Horseshoe Bowl (lift access) or Imperial Bowl at 12,998 ft via the new highest lift in North America! Hike to Lake Chutes for a 55 degree pitch (extreme terrain), between 10 and 80 feet of cornice, rocks to jump and of course, fresh tracks. Peak 9 features tree skiing at its best. The Windows is an easy hike (anywhere from 10 to 20 minutes depending on a skier or rider's speed) from the Patrol Hut atop Peak 9. The South Side of Peak 10 sports big fat bumps, hidden kickers and glades - all without seeing another soul (or at least many souls).

THE TOWN OF BRECKENRIDGE

Before Breckenridge became a world famous ski resort, it was a town -- a mining town but a great quaint Victorian town. Over the past 150 years (just celebrated in 2009), the spirit of the town hasn't changed much. Part outcast, beautiful, frontier living, and relaxing. The Town of Breckenridge provides free transportation both from the Breckenridge Ski Resort and the town of Breckenridge. A visitor favorite is the BreckConnect high-speed gondola which runs from the town of Breckenridge providing access to the Breckenridge Ski Area and several lodging properties. Breckenridge is also served by the Summit Stage providing free bus service throughout Summit County including Keystone and Arapahoe Basin. Roundtrip shuttle transportation is available to Beaver Creek and Vail for \$35 per person if pre-arranged. Additionally, Breckenridge offers plenty of activities for the non-skier including snowmobiling, snowshoeing, ice skating, dogsledding, and sleigh rides. The charming town of Breckenridge also has quaint restaurants and plenty of shopping opportunities with more than 200 stores throughout the city.

LIFT-TICKETS

THE COLORADO "LIFT-TICKET" (Allows access to 10,100 acres of skiing at 5 resorts!)

Included with your trip price is the "**Colorado Lift-Ticket**"! Our 3-out-of-4 day lift-tickets (and the optional upgradable to the 4-out-of-5 day lift-tickets) has a very special bonus in that they are also valid at Keystone and Arapahoe Basin Ski Resorts accessible by a free shuttle. Plus, our lift-tickets give limited access to Beaver Creek and Vail Ski Resorts (roundtrip shuttle cost is \$35 pp), which, combined with the three aforementioned resorts, the "Colorado Lift-Ticket" gives you a total access to five resorts and 10,100 acres. The 3-out-of-4 day lift ticket allows you to use one day at Beaver Creek and Vail Resorts while a 4-out-of-5 day lift-ticket gives you up to two days access to Beaver Creek and Vail.

NON-SKIER LIFT-TICKET

A one-day non-skier (foot passenger) lift ticket is available for purchase at the Breckenridge Ski Resort for about \$25. This lift-ticket allows non-skiers to ride the Colorado and the QuickSilver Super Chairs. For the best view, the Colorado Super Chair would be the best option as it goes a bit further up the mountain to 11,059 ft. where you can have lunch at the Vista Haus, which offers fantastic views of the Continental Divide at 11,000 feet. You can also meet up with skier group for lunch on the mountain.

SKI-IN/SKI-OUT ACCOMMODATIONS:

We are staying the the beautiful ski-in/ski-out 5-star *BlueSky Condominiums* (www.blueskybreckenridgecolorado.com). Just built in 2008, we have two-bedroom condos reserved at this luxury property, providing for the perfect combination of alpine elegance and slopeside location. Situated just three blocks off Main Street Breckenridge



and adjacent to the Snowflake lift, BlueSky offers the ideal ski-in/ski-out experience from the center of town. These million-dollar condos combine the quiet and comfort of a private residence with the personal service of a fine hotel. The Snowflake Lift is just outside the door where you can jump on the lift for direct mountain access. At the end of the day, take the Snowflake Trail right to the door of BlueSky. Ski and boot lockers are just inside the door offering the complete Breckenridge ski-in/ski-out experience.



(www.chartersports.com), a ski and snowboard rental shop, is located on the premises of BlueSky, which makes it convenient and quick to rent skis or snowboard equipment. BlueSky Condos are proud to feature The Spa at Breckenridge, a full service spa offering pampering treatments and wellness services. Open daily 9am-7pm Monday – Saturday and 10am-6pm on Sundays. The condo complex also offers a heated outdoor swimming pool and three hot-tubs with beautiful views of the trees and surrounding mountains.

A Fitness Center with state-of-the-art Precor equipment is available for use during your stay. A private residents' lounge is also open to guests where you can sit by the fire, watch TV, or play games. Two computers are available to guests with internet and printing access, which are complimentary for guests. A gameroom is also onsite offering video games, DVD Rentals, air hockey, cable TV, change machines and vending machines. BlueSky condos offer a complimentary shuttle to and from Breckenridge town locations. There is also a Breckenridge town shuttle bus stop located outside Level 1 by the Snowflake Lift. Charter Sports carry an extensive selection of the latest winter and technical gear from Descente, Arcteryx, and Spyder, fashionable clothing from Obermeyer, Betty Rides, and Roxy, and gloves and accessories from Swamy, Scott USA, Oakley, and Maui Jim. Choose Charter Sports to prepare for winter adventure! Equipment pick-up, drop-off, and rental gear storage is available at any convenient Charter Sports shop. Although ski and snowboard rentals are not included in the price of the trip, a special negotiated discounted rate of 40% off their ski and snowboard packages is offered to our group.

OPTIONS:

EXTRA DAY LIFT-TICKET: A 3-out-of-4 day lift ticket is included with your trip package price. However, you may upgrade to a 4-out-of-5 day lift-ticket for just \$39 more. The 4-out-of-5 day lift-ticket grants you access to not only Breckenridge, but also to Keystone and Arapahoe Basin (free shuttle), but also provides access up to two days to Beaver Creek and Vail Resorts (roundtrip shuttle is \$35 each day). **(\$39)**

We will climb aboard a hand-crafted oak sleigh and nestle ourselves under an antique lap robe. A handsome team of mules will take us down a secluded, picturesque trail. Waiting for us at the end of the trail we'll find a warm and cozy camp tucked deep in the woods where we will be served the best dinner available this side of the Continental Divide. Camp life includes a personal touch, excellent music, and live entertainment. Even if it's two below zero outside, we'll warm up to their service and hospitality. The hearty dinner consists of a southwestern soup (with just enough kick to warm you up), variety of handcrafted artisan rolls, prime cuts New York strip steak & chicken breast (marinated & grilled to perfection), baked potato with sour cream, mixed vegetables, warm apple pie with whipped cream, hot cocoa, variety of teas & fresh roasted ground coffee. **(\$58)**

All claims must be dealt directly with Adams & Associates. Note: Those over age 70 will have a \$10,000 Accidental Death & Dismemberment Benefit. The Disability coverage cannot apply to those aged 70+. **You are encouraged to purchase this Emergency Services & Travel Coverage.**

OPTIONAL TRIP CANCELLATION INSURANCE: Adams & Associates International also offers this program, **but you must enroll directly with them and pay the premium directly to them.** To enroll online or to find out more information, go to their website at www.aaintl.com/ITravelInsured.cfm. According to their website, the cost of this insurance for this trip is **\$32.70** (\$5.45 per day x 6 days). ACCEPTANCE, REGISTRATION, AND DEPOSIT: You are not signed up for this trip until your **trip registration form is received and accepted, and a deposit of \$250 is paid.**

GROUP HARMONY: To ensure the desired group synergy, Peter Tadin reserves the right to accept, reject or expel any individual who is deemed incompatible with the interests of the group or becomes disruptive. All expenses to do so will be borne by the passenger

PAYMENTS: Your **\$250** deposit will become your first payment **at time of registration**. A second payment of **\$248** will be due by **October 14th**.
